

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the select committee shall be named the "Select
2 House Committee on Water Utility Tax Credits" and shall be composed of the following
3 seven members:

4 (1) Three members from the House Committee on Commerce appointed by the
5 speaker of the House of Representatives.

6 (2) Three members from the House Committee on Ways and Means appointed by
7 the speaker of the House of Representatives.

8 (3) One state representative from the Northshore Legislative Delegation appointed
9 by the speaker of the House of Representatives.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state representative from the Northshore
11 Legislative Delegation shall serve as chair of the select committee.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives
13 shall designate staff to assist the committee in its work.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the select committee shall submit a report of its
15 findings and recommendations to the members of the House of Representatives of the
16 Legislature of Louisiana and the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library no later than
17 thirty days prior to the convening of the 2027 Regular Session.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the select committee
19 shall terminate upon the convening of the 2027 Regular Session.

Wright

Creates a select committee of the House of Representatives to study the potential establishment of a state income tax credit for water utility customers who pay excessive rates for residential water service. Requires the select committee to report its findings and recommendations to the House of Representatives no later than 30 days prior to the convening of the 2027 R.S.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the engrossed bill:

1. Provide for the creation of a select committee, rather than subcommittee, of the House of Representatives.

2. Provide for the speaker of the House of Representatives to designate staff to assist the committee.
