**Abstract:** Authorizes licensees to offer promotional play wagers not in excess of \$5M or the annual percentage cap.

Present law provides that licensees may offer up to \$5M in promotional play wagers per year that are not calculated as "net slot machine proceeds".

Proposed law provides that a licensee may offer up to \$5M or up to the percentage cap established by the following schedule:

- (1) 4% of taxable revenue for tax year 2027.
- (2) 7% of taxable revenue for tax year 2028.
- (3) 10% of taxable revenue for tax year 2029 and each tax year thereafter.

Proposed law provides that promotional play wagers do not include any locally dedicated funds from net slot machine proceeds.

(Amends R.S. 27:353(intro. para.), (9), and (11))

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to the original bill:

1. Change the type of gaming facility to which proposed law applies from riverboat casinos and the land-based casino to racetrack casinos.

### The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Clarify that promotional play wagers do not include any locally dedicated funds from net slot machine proceeds.
2. Make technical changes.
