

1 (i) A law enforcement agency may authorize its employees to create or transmit
2 reports required by this Article through a secure web based platform designated by the
3 agency. An agency may only designate one secure web based platform for its employees to
4 use to create or transmit the reports, and the agency may designate a secure web based
5 platform only if the following conditions are met:

6 (aa) The secure web based platform functions in compliance with applicable federal
7 law.

8 (bb) The agency is satisfied that the secure web based platform complies with the
9 Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, Federal Bureau of Investigation's
10 Criminal Justice Information Services Security Policy, or Family Educational Rights and
11 Privacy Act, as applicable.

12 (cc) The secure web based platform provider demonstrates to the agency that it has
13 been deemed compliant with the relevant security standard by a federal, state, or local
14 government agency or by a third party that has been approved by a federal, state, or local
15 government agency for security and compliance attestation.

16 (ii) A law enforcement agency that utilizes a secure web based platform shall notify
17 the Department of Children and Family Services not less than ten days before implementing
18 the secure web based platform. The notice shall identify the name of the secure web based
19 platform provider and any domain names utilized by the secure web based platform to
20 submit reports."
