AN ACT

To provide relative to state highways; to designate a portion of United States Highway 425 in Wisner, Louisiana, as the "Gladys Edwards Highway"; to provide for location and placement of signage; to provide for restrictions on costs of materials to the department; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, United States Highway 425, beginning at the northern city limit and ending at the southern city limit, all situated within the city of Wisner, Louisiana, in Franklin Parish is hereby designated as "Gladys Edwards Highway".

Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars per sign.
