 Provides relative to the use of automatic dependent surveillance-broadcast systems

Proposed law provides that no person or entity may use information broadcast or collected by automatic surveillance-broadcast systems as a means for calculating, generating, and collecting fees or taxes from aircraft owners or operators who operate aircraft with a maximum certificated takeoff weight of 12,495 pounds or less and operate under 14 CFR Part 91 and 14 CFR Part 141; provides for a fine of not more than \$500 for each occurrence.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION


There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in a decrease in Local Funds revenues for airports or local governing authorities that currently use automatic dependent surveillance-broadcast (ADS-B) systems to collect fees or taxes. Proposed law prohibits entities from using ADS-B systems to collect fees or taxes on small airplanes that operate under 14 CFR Part 91 or 14 CFR Part 141. The Louisiana Airport Managers Association reports that at least two airports in Louisiana are using ADS-B to charge landing fees, but most of these fees are waived for the small airplanes that operate under 14 CFR Part 91 or 14 CFR Part 141. The exact fiscal impact is indeterminable, as it is unknown the exact number of publicly owned airports that collect landing fees on these aircraft or how many local governing authorities collect taxes using ADS-B, and how much revenue each entity is currently collecting using ADS-B.
