HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES: Requests the Louisiana Department of Health to study and report on gaps in acute healthcare access for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Creates the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Acute Care and Crisis Response Task Force.
2. Provides for the membership, duties, and operation of the task force.
3. Establishes that the task force shall terminate upon conclusion of its business or Jan. 31, 2027, whichever occurs later.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Creates the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD) Acute Care and Crisis Response Task Force (task force) to study acute healthcare access, crisis stabilization services, care coordination, and emergency response systems for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and to develop recommendations to improve healthcare outcomes and continuity of care for such individuals.

Requires the La. Dept. of Health to submit a report by Feb. 1, 2027.

Provides that the task force shall terminate upon conclusion of its business or Jan. 30, 2027, whichever occurs first.
