APPROPRIATIONS: Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2026-2027

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Provide for net increases (decreases) in appropriations as follows: (\$113,897,084) in State General Fund (Direct); \$24,642,711 in Interagency Transfers; \$17,724,681 in Fees and Self-generated Revenues; \$1,265,090,910 in Statutory Dedications; and (\$30,098,830) in Federal Funds.

3. Appropriates \$850,000,000 from the Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund, in the event House Bill No. 313 becomes law. Provides for the transfer of these trust fund monies in the following amounts, to the following funds:
