HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 350

A RESOLUTION

To designate Sunday, June 7, 2026, as Reggio Family Clock Donation Day in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Louisiana citizens are heirs to and benefactors of a rich and diverse historical tapestry; and

WHEREAS, each year, communities and museums across Louisiana celebrate the history of the state and its artifacts; and

WHEREAS, in museums across Louisiana, precious artifacts are curated and preserved and presented to the citizens of Louisiana and those interested in gaining a broader understanding of the past, present, and hope for the future of the state; and

WHEREAS, Godfrey "Frey" Reggio, III, and the Reggio family will present the Reggio Family Clock to the Cabildo in New Orleans for display as a part of its permanent collections during the Gálvez and Louisiana in the American Revolution exhibition; and

WHEREAS, this timepiece was crafted around 1751 and has been handed down from its original owner, François Marie, Chevalier de Reggio; the artifact is a small but tangible link to the objects and people present during some of most pivotal moments in Louisiana history.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Sunday, June 7, 2026, as Reggio Family Clock Donation Day in Louisiana and does hereby encourage all citizens of Louisiana to share in the joy of this special day.
