HEALTH/CANCER: Provides with respect to the advisory board created to recommend new treatments for rare cancers

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Extends the deadline for submitting written reports from 30 days to 45 days following each meeting.
2. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law provides for the composition of the advisory board for rare cancer treatments and provides for meetings and reporting requirements.

Proposed law increases the board’s membership from 15 to 17 and makes the following changes to the composition:

- (1) Increases the number of oncologists who sit on the board from two to four.
- (2) Removes the executive director of Taking Aim at Cancer in Louisiana and adds the executive director of the Cancer Association of Louisiana.

Present law requires the advisory board to hold quarterly public meetings unless otherwise provided.

Proposed law changes the deadline for submitting written reports from 30 to 45 days after each meeting and also requires that the reports be submitted to the House and Senate committees on insurance, instead of the legislature.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
