1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 39:330.1(A)(3), relative to the sale of surplus state-owned property; to provide
3 for preference of in-state auctioneers; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
4 for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 39:330.1(A)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §330.1. Sale of surplus property

8 A.(1)

9 * * *

10 (3) Where both in-state and out-of-state auctioneers are bidding, in-state
11 auctioneers shall be given preference, provided the services are equal in quality and
12 do not exceed cost by more than ten percent of services available from outside the
13 state. The provisions of this Paragraph shall apply to auctions conducted pursuant to
14 Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Subsection.

15 * * *

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5 effective on the day following such approval.
