PUBLIC MEETINGS EN NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
 Provides relative to public meetings

Present law provides that school boards must allow public comment at any meeting of the school board prior to taking any vote. Proposed law provides that such comment shall be subject to reasonable rules, regulations, and restrictions as adopted by the school board. Proposed law provides that any posted meeting notices must be located where the public can read them. Proposed law provides that a draft of meeting minutes must be provided to the members of the public body at least five business days prior to the meeting at which the minutes will be considered for approval. Proposed law provides that if a public body has a website, a copy of the adopted minutes must be made available on said website.
