ACT 2 (SB 2)

2025 First Extraordinary Session

New law authorizes a special statewide election to be held on Saturday, May 16, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the state proposed constitutional amendments contained in joint resolutions concurred in by each house of the legislature during the 2025 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

New law provides that the April 18, 2026, date for submission of constitutional amendments contained in the following Acts be changed to May 16, 2026:

- (1) Act No. 218, §2 of the 2025 Regular Session.
- (2) Act No. 219, §2 of the 2025 Regular Session.
- (3) Act No. 221, §3 of the 2025 Regular Session.
- (4) Act No. 222, §8 of the 2025 Regular Session.
- (5) Act No. 223, §2 of the 2025 Regular Session.

New law provides that the May 16, 2026, election be held in compliance with applicable provisions of the Louisiana Election Code.

Prior law authorized a special statewide election to be held on April 18, 2026, for submission of proposed constitutional amendments to the voters.

New law repeals this provision.

Effective October 30, 2025.
