1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:2009.10.2, relative to nursing facilities; to provide for a statewide quality
3 oversight initiative for nursing facilities; to provide for goals and strategies; to
4 provide for the duties and responsibilities of the Louisiana Department of Health; to
5 provide for reporting; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:2009.10.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 **§2009.10.2. Statewide quality oversight for nursing facilities; state**
9 **requirements**

10 **A. The Louisiana Department of Health shall develop a statewide quality**
11 **oversight initiative for nursing facilities.**

12 **(1) The short-term goal of the initiative shall be to stabilize performance**
13 **of facilities by identifying gaps, deploying targeted incentives, aligning**
14 **interventions with the most pressing quality risks, and identifying funding for**
15 **execution of the initiative.**

16 **(2) The long-term goal shall be to create a more robust statewide quality**
17 **oversight system capable of supporting and driving continuous improvement**
18 **and overall system level changes.**

19 **(3) Stakeholders, including trade and advocacy associations, individuals**
20 **engaged in the daily operational practice of nursing facility care, and quality**
21 **improvement organizations, shall be identified and utilized by the department**
22 **to build a coordinated approach centered on collaboration, education, and**
23 **practical tools.**

24 **B. The Louisiana Department of Health, through the office of aging and**
25 **adult services, shall identify and develop internal subject-matter experts to**
26 **support the statewide quality oversight initiative. The department may utilize**

1 such efforts as considered appropriate, including but not limited to:

2 (1) Data dashboards and public-facing online tools.

3 (2) Resident and family satisfaction surveys.

4 (3) Staff training plans and ongoing staff training and development.

5 (4) Participation in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services

6 Nursing Home Staffing Campaign.

7 C. The department shall submit an initial report to the Senate and House

8 committees on health and welfare on the status of the statewide quality

9 oversight initiative on January 1, 2028, and annually on the first of January

10 thereafter.
