Jordan

New law requires each public postsecondary education institution to do the following:

- (1) Post on its website, and have printed on student identification cards, the following information:
 - (a) The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline hotline number, "988", with an explanation that this number may be called or texted.
 - (b) A local suicide prevention hotline number, if available, and a state suicide prevention hotline number, if available.
- (2) Implement the following initiatives:
 - (a) Provide information to each student about mental health and suicide prevention services and early warning signs for a person who may be considering suicide.
 - (b) Provide that individuals with training in mental health and suicide-related issues are available either on campus or remotely for students 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- (3) Develop and implement a system for collecting and reporting data on suicide risk assessments conducted by the institution.

Effective August 1, 2026.
