ACT 592 (SB 47)

Mizell

Existing law provides for the publication of certain information concerning boards, commissions, and like entities. Requires that certain information be included on the boards and commissions website maintained by the commissioner of administration.

Existing law requires that this boards and commissions website include contact information, including the name of one or more contacts at the board, commission, or like entity; a mailing address; an e-mail address; a website address; and a phone number.

New law retains existing law and requires that the website contact information include the phone number of at least two contacts at the board or commission, including the chairman and the executive director or administrator, if applicable and an email address for each member of the board or commission.

New law shall not require the use of public funds to provide a phone to a board member. Requires that the board chairman serve as the board's emergency contact.

New law provides that no email shall be required for each member of a parish board of election supervisors. Provides that the contact information for the parish board of election supervisors be the phone number and website listed be the Department of State elections hotline number and website.

Effective July 1, 2027.
