Miller

Existing law provides for circumstances when a polling place for a particular precinct is not required to be opened.

New law retains existing law but adds a additional circumstance when the precinct is not required to be opened which is if the registrar of voters determines there are less than 20 eligible voters in the voting district in the precinct for any office or proposition on the ballot and the location of the polling place serves as the polling place of another precinct, the remaining eligible voters may vote pursuant to existing law at another polling place in the same polling location.

Effective August 1, 2026.
