Existing law creates the La. Protective Order Registry (registry), administered by the judicial administrator's office of the La. Supreme Court to collect statewide data relative to abuse prevention orders that is transmitted from courts, law enforcement, and private process servers of the state and entered into the registry.

New law authorizes the judicial administrator's office to develop and implement a statewide portal allowing petitioners to file online a petition requesting any authorized protective order and requires that the petition requesting contain a written affirmation signed and dated by the petitioner that the facts and circumstances contained in the petition are true and correct, under penalty of perjury. Requires that the affirmation be executed before a witness, who is to sign and print his name.

Effective August 1, 2026.
