Reese

Existing law requires the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (Board) to adopt rules to provide for the establishment of a list of persons who are to be excluded from any room, premises, or designated gaming area of any establishment where gaming is conducted pursuant to an issued license or contract.

New law retains existing law but requires the Board to adopt rules excluding those persons who, before, during, or after a sporting event, threaten violence or harm against any person who is involved in the sporting event, where the threat is related to sports gaming, whose presence in a retail sports book or whose participation in the play or operation of mobile wagering in this state is determined by the Board to pose a threat to the interests of the state, or to the strict and effective regulation of sports wagering.

Effective August 1, 2026.
