Existing law provides that state police will create and operate a statewide sexual assault collection kit tracking system and that all entities, including law enforcement and healthcare providers having custody of sexual assault collection kits, will provide certain information to the tracking system and fully participate in it.

New law requires the district attorney to submit sexual assault collection kits to the tracking system.

New law otherwise retains existing law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
