Existing law makes it unlawful for a person to produce, promote, advertise, distribute, possess, or possess with the intent to distribute child sexual abuse materials.

New law retains existing law and adds that it is also unlawful for a person to use an image of a natural person who was under 17 years of age at the time the image was created, or an image that depicts a person who appears to be under 17 years of age, with the intent to train an artificial intelligence model to produce child sexual abuse materials.

New law otherwise retains existing law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
