New law prohibits from inclusion in public records certain information that would identify someone who served on a jury.

New law does not apply to juror information submitted to a local government.

New law creates an exception for when a court finds good cause following a motion to disclose the identifying information.

New law provides a penalty of up to \$1,000 or six months imprisonment, or both, for violations of new law.

New law adds an exception to existing law regarding public records.

New law applies prospectively only.

Effective August 1, 2026.
