Existing law provides a mileage allowance for jurors for mileage necessarily traveled going to and from the courthouse for criminal trials.

Prior law provided, in criminal trials, for a mileage allowance of not less than 16¢ per mile nor more than the rate in effect for state officials.

New law provides, in criminal trials, for a mileage allowance equal to the rate in effect for state officials for each mile necessarily traveled in going and returning from the courthouse.

Existing law provides a mileage allowance for jury commissioners for mileage necessarily traveled going to and from the place of a meeting.

Prior law provided for a mileage amount of 21¢ per mile for jury commissioners.

New law requires a mileage allowance for jury commissioners of not less than 21¢ per mile nor more than the rate in effect for state officials.

Effective August 1, 2026.
