Existing law provides for the retention and ownership of the notes, recordings, and other records of civil and criminal court matters.

New law provides that the custody and control of the notes, recordings, and other records of the court proceedings remain with the court when a court reporter retires or leaves the employ of the court.

Effective August 1, 2026.
