Existing law provides for motions to expunge.

New law requires someone making a motion to expunge arrest information to also provide, if they exist, criminal background checks, a certification letter from the district attorney verifying the applicant has no convictions or pending charges, court minutes showing final disposition, and the charging instrument to the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information in addition to the motion to expunge.

Effective August 1, 2026.
