ACT 561 (HB 664)

Existing law provides for a maximum penalty that may be imposed for the violation of a parish ordinance consisting of a maximum fine and imprisonment of 30 days in the parish jail.

Prior law provided for a maximum fine of \$500. New law provides for an increase of the maximum fine from \$500 to \$1,500.

Existing law provides for a maximum penalty that may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance as codified in Title 11 or 13 of the Code of Ordinances for the parish of East Baton Rouge and the city of Baton Rouge consisting of a maximum fine and imprisonment of six months in the parish jail.

Prior law provided for a maximum fine of \$1,000. New law provides for an increase of the maximum fine from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

Existing law provides that in Jefferson Parish, except as to properties zoned or used for industrial activities, the maximum penalty which may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance consists of a maximum fine and imprisonment of six months in the parish jail.

Prior law provided for a maximum fine of \$1,000. New law provides for an increase of the maximum fine that may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance in Jefferson Parish from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

Effective August 1, 2026.
