Existing law creates the Spring Lake Subdivision Improvement District as a special taxing district in Orleans Parish for the primary purpose of promoting and encouraging the beautification, security, and overall betterment of Spring Lake Subdivision. Provides for the boundaries, governance, and powers and duties of the district.

Existing law authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans, subject to voter approval, to levy and collect special taxes or fees on all taxable real property situated within the boundaries of the district, for a term not to exceed eight years. Authorizes the governing authority to levy a special ad valorem tax not to exceed five mills per year.

Prior law authorized the governing authority to levy fees not to exceed \$200 per year. New law increases the maximum fees authorized to be levied to \$325 per year.

New law provides that the amount of the taxes or fees may be changed by duly adopted resolution of the board, not to exceed the maximum amount.

Existing law provides for renewal of the taxes and fees. New law provides that the term of renewal shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing renewal, not to exceed eight years.

Effective upon lapse of time for gubernatorial action (May 18, 2026).
