ACT 403 (HB 735)

Jackson

Prior law authorized the commissioner of administration and the secretary of the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to transfer certain state property in Caddo Parish to either the LSU Health Sciences Center Shreveport or the LSU Health Sciences Foundation Shreveport.

New law repeals prior law.

Existing law authorizes the commissioner of administration to administer and supervise state property and requires that the commissioner be a party to any transaction involving immovable property of the state.

New law requires that the DOTD transfer certain state property in Caddo Parish to the LSU Health Sciences Center Shreveport, in accordance with existing law.

New law provides that the commissioner of administration and the secretary of the DOTD are authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the transfer.

New law requires the LSU Health Sciences Center Shreveport to record the transfer in the conveyance records for Caddo Parish.

New law requires that the transfer be effective July 1, 2026.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action (May 23, 2026).
