Existing law authorizes the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C), office of motor vehicles (OMV), to issue identification stickers or decals to symbolize awareness for certain disabilities, at no cost to the driver or parent or legal guardian.

New law authorizes the DPS&C, OMV, to create specially designed envelopes to be provided to drivers with mental, physical, developmental disabilities, or autism spectrum disorder, or their parents or legal guardians, that provide proof as required by existing law. Specifies that the envelopes include guidelines to assist officers in recognizing and effectively communicating with drivers with disabilities during traffic stops.

Effective August 1, 2026.
