Existing law provides for treatment, vocational, and rehabilitation programming offered to inmates through the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C).

Existing law provides that an eligible inmate who earns a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited and a DPS&C-approved educational institution while incarcerated is eligible to earn an additional 90 days of "good time" credit.

New law adds an associate's degree as a qualifying degree that entitles an inmate to an additional 90 days of "good time" credit.

Effective August 1, 2026.
