ACT 877 (HB 1129)

Existing law authorizes the commissioner of administration to sell state-owned surplus movable property at public auction, either live or via the internet. Authorizes the commissioner of administration to hire qualified licensed auctioneers to handle the sale.

New law gives a preference for an in-state auctioneer over an out-of-state auctioneer where services provided are equal in quality and do not exceed in cost by more than 10% of services available from out-of-state auctioneers. The preference applies to auctions held at public auction and by internet sale.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 9, 2026).
