Existing law prohibits any person from intentionally misbranding or misrepresenting certain food products as an agricultural product through various activities, including intentionally misbranding or representing a cell cultured food product as a meat product.

New law requires that any cell cultured food product bear a clear and conspicuous disclosure identifying the product in a bold typed print of not less than 30-point font.

Effective August 1, 2026.
