Horton

Existing law provides for violations of probation.

Existing law provides that any defendant who has been placed on probation for an offense other than a crime of violence or a sex offense and who has been determined by the court to have committed a technical violation of his probation may be required to serve a sentence of not more than 90 days without diminution of sentence.

New law provides that if the sentence is to be served in a custodial substance abuse treatment program, the defendant may be required to serve a sentence of not more than 180 days without diminution of sentence.

Effective August 1, 2026.
