Melerine

Existing law provides relative to the confidentiality, authorized release, violations, and exceptions pertaining to testimony presented in executive session before the Board of Pardons and committee on parole.

New law prohibits the assessment of any fees or costs against a victim, spouse or next of kin of a deceased victim, or legal guardian of a victim who requests a copy of testimony that was presented in executive session before the Board of Pardons and committee on parole.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 22, 2026).
