Existing law provides for the crime of violation of protective orders.

New law provides that a person may be found criminally liable for intentionally evading service of process for certain lawful orders issued by a court relative to injunctions, protective orders, temporary restraining orders, and Uniform Abuse Prevention Orders.

Effective August 1, 2026.
