Urges and requests that the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD), in conjunction with DOTD District 4, study the recent occurrences of rainwater flooding along a segment of the La. Hwy. 1 corridor in Shreveport, La. Requires the DOTD to incorporate the input, expertise, and support of relevant local municipal entities, including the Shreveport Dept. of Operational Services, Office of Water and Sewerage, Shreveport Traffic Engineering, and the Caddo Parish Office of Homeland Security. Requires the DOTD submit a written report detailing its findings and recommendations, including proposed plans to mitigate flooding, for inclusion in DOTD's Statewide Flood Control Program, to the joint transportation committee, the state representative for La. House District No. 2, and the state senator for La. Senate District No. 39 at least 60 days prior to the convening of the 2027 R.S.
