Existing law provides that a survivor of sexual assault must be provided with any medication during a forensic medical examination, including emergency contraception and HIV or STI prophylaxis.

New law modifies existing law, requiring the healthcare provider to provide HIV or STI post-exposure prophylaxis administered in accordance with the Drug Information Handbook during a forensic medical examination.

Effective August 1, 2026.
