2026 Regular Session

McFarland

New law provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for FY 2026-2027.

Appropriates \$46.2 B in total funding, of which \$11.7 B is State General Fund (Direct). Compared to FY 25-26 existing operating budget (as of December 1, 2025), SGF appropriations in the FY 25-26 budget decreased by \$183.2 M and total state effort (SGF , Fees and Self-generated Revenues, and Statutory Dedications) decreased by \$904.3 M.

Other means of financing from FY 26-27 include: \$1.4 B in Interagency Transfers; \$3.8 B in Fees and Self-generated Revenues; \$5.9 B in Statutory Dedications; and \$23.5 B in Federal Funds. Compared to FY 25-26 existing operating budget, new law increases \$19.2 M in Interagency Transfers, reduces \$109 M in Fees and Self-generated Revenues, reduces \$612.2 M in Statutory Dedications, and decreases of \$1.2 B in Federal Funds.

New law appropriates \$6.8 M by State General Fund (Direct) in FY 26-27 for the payment of judgments against the state of La.

New law appropriates \$850 M by Statutory Dedications out of the Revenue Stabilization Fund and transfers the monies as follows:

- (1) \$387.2 M into the La. Transportation Infrastructure Fund.
- (2) \$98 M into the La. Economic Development Initiatives Fund.
- (3) \$85.4 M into the Capital Outlay Savings Fund.
- (4) \$82.8 M into the Strategic Investments Across Louisiana Fund.
- (5) \$73 M into the High Impact Job Fund.
- (6) \$37.2 M into the Criminal Justice and First Responder Fund.
- (7) \$36 M into the State Emergency Response Fund.
- (8) \$25 M into the Major Events Incentive Fund.
- (9) \$7.3 M into the Higher Education Campus Revitalization Fund.
- (10) \$4.5 M into the Modernization and Security Fund.
- (11) \$3 M into the Oyster Resource Management Account.
- (12) \$3 M into the Criminal Justice Technology Innovation Fund.
- (13) \$2.5 M into the La. Rural Infrastructure Revolving Loan Program Fund.
- (14) \$2.5 M into the Reading Enrichment and Academic Deliverables Fund.
- (15) \$1.7 M into the Federal Energy Settlement Fund.
- (16) \$1 M into the La. Charter School Start-Up and Expansion Loan Fund.
