Existing law provides relative to plans submitted to the fire marshal.

Existing law provides that in the event that plans do not appear to the fire marshal to satisfactorily comply with the laws, regulations, and codes of La. and the regulations of the state fire marshal, the fire marshal shall furnish a letter to the submitting party listing the requirements which must be met before the plans can be stamped "Reviewed" and before construction or renovation work can begin. Existing law provides that no list of requirements shall be provided if the plans are submitted in violation of existing law, R.S. 37:155(A)(4).

New law adds that no list of requirements shall be provided if plans are submitted in violation of existing law, R.S. 37:701(I).

Effective August 1, 2026.
