The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Dennis C. Weber.

DIGEST

Present law provides for the following:

- (1) For the first failure to register as a sex offender, a fine of not more that \$1,000 or imprisonment, with or without hard labor for not less than one nor more than five years or both.
- (2) For a second or subsequent offense, the fine is not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$2,500 or imprisonment with or without hard labor for not less than three nor more than 10 years or both fine and imprisonment.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the penalty for failure to register as a sex offender and provides for the following:

- (1) For the first failure to register as a sex offender, there is a mandatary fine of \$1,000 and a minium term of imprisonment of five years and a maximum term of imprisonment of 10 years without benefit of parol, probation or suspension of sentence. Both fine and imprisonment are mandatory.
- (2) For second or subsequent offense, the fine is increased to \$3,000. The term of imprisonment is increased to a minium of 10 years and a maximum of 20 years without benefit of parol, probation or suspension of sentence. Both fine and imprisonment are mandatory.
