VOTERS/VOTING. Authorizes a person who has registered by mail and has not previously voted in the parish in which he is registered to vote absentee by mail during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency.

2	To enact R.S. 18:115(F)(2)(d), relative to the registration of voters; to provide for the
3	authority of a voter who has registered by mail who has not previously voted in the
4	parish in which he is registered during certain emergencies; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 18:115(F)(2)(d) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§115. Registration by mail

11	(2) The provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall not apply in the
12	case of the following:

14	(d) A person who has registered by mail and has not previously voted in
15	the parish in which he is registered voting during a state of emergency declared
16	by the governor.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides that any registered voter who has registered by mail and has not previously voted in the parish in which he is registered shall vote: (a) during early voting in the office of the registrar of voters, or (b) in person at the precinct in which he is registered to vote. <u>Present law</u> specifies exceptions.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds to such exceptions such a voter seeking to vote during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency or disaster.
