Gallot HB No. 32

**Abstract:** Provides for the suspension of performance of a contract due to the impracticability of performance of the contract.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the impossibility of performance of contracts.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the applicability of <u>proposed law</u> to existing contracts unless the parties agree otherwise.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the suspension of performance of contracts due to impracticability.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that performance is impracticable when the burden has increased beyond any reasonable expectation of the parties.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the liability of the obligor who was in default at the time the impracticability arose.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for proportional suspension or reduction of counterperformance in the case of partial performance.

Proposed law provides that hurricanes Katrina and Rita are fortuitous events.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the suspension of monetary payments.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the retroactive application of <u>proposed law</u> to August 26, 2005.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
