PUBLIC CONTRACTS: Increases the contract limit on certain public contracts let by the division of administration resulting from a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #21)

| 12 | (d) The term "contract limit" as used herein shall be equal to the sum of one |
| 13 | hundred thousand dollars per project, including labor, materials, and equipment as |
| 14 | per the rates in the latest edition of the Associated Equipment Dealers Rental Rate |
| 15 | Book and administrative overhead not to exceed fifteen percent; however: |

| 17 | (iv) For projects let by the facility planning and control section of the |
| 18 | division of administration which are necessitated by an event which has been |
| 19 | gubernatorially declared as a disaster or emergency, the contract limit shall be five |
| 20 | hundred thousand dollars. |

- 1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- 3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 5 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Increases the contract limit for projects of the facility planning and control section of the division of administration which are let as a result of a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the dollar limit, known as the "contract limit", for public works above which the contracting public entity is required to advertise for bids for performance of the contract and award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder. The contract limit is \$100,000.

<u>Present law</u> provides for exceptions for the contract limit for certain projects for the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and also for certain bridge construction building projects for political subdivisions with populations of less than 16,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that the contract limit for disaster recovery projects let by the facility planning and control section of the division of administration shall be \$500,000 when such projects are undertaken due to a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
