APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Appropriates monies from the State General Fund (Direct) for FY 2005-2006 to the Department of Corrections for hospitalization costs of prisoners housed in parish jails (Item #30)

AN ACT

2	To provide for supplemental appropriations for the Department of Correction out of the
3	State General Fund (Direct) for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 for payment of
4	hospitalization costs of prisoners housed in parish jails, and to pay for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The sum of Eight Million One Hundred Thousand and No/100
8	(\$8,100,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the State General Fund (Direct) for
9	Fiscal Year 2005-2006 to the DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, 08-400, for payment
10	of hospitalization costs of prisoners housed in parish jails.
11	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
13	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
14	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15	effective on the day following such approval.
