ADMINISTRATION: Suspends requirement for preparation of annual undersecretary's report for FY 2004-2005 (Item #23)

1	AN ACT
2	To suspend and otherwise to make of no effect, for purposes of Fiscal Year 2004-2005, the
3	preparation of an annual report by an undersecretary with respect to activities of his
4	office as provided in R.S. 36:8(B); and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. For purposes of Fiscal Year 2004-2005, the provisions of R.S. 36:8(B)
7	requiring an undersecretary to prepare an annual report summarizing the activities of his
8	office relating to management and program analysis are suspended and of no effect.
9	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
10	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
1	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
12	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
13	effective on the day following such approval.
