PUBLIC CONTRACTS. Provides with respect to the contract limits for public contracts for public works projects administered by the office of facility planning and control, division of administration, necessitated as a result of a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency. (gov sig)

| 11 | and reenacted and R.S. 38:2212(A)(1)(d)(iv) is hereby enacted to read as follows:            |
| 12 | §2212. Advertisement and letting to lowest responsible bidder; public work;                  |
| 13 | electronic bidding; participation in mentor-protégé program                                  |

| 16 | (d) Except as provided in R.S. 38:2212(A)(1)(d)(iv) herein, the term                         |
| 17 | "contract limit" as used herein shall be equal to the sum of one hundred thousand            |

| 26 | Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not          |
| 27 | signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature |
| 28 | by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  |
| 29 | vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become    |

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effective on the day following such approval.

## DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides that all public work exceeding the contract limit, including labor and materials to be done by a public body, shall be advertised and let to the lowest responsible bidder.

<u>Present law</u> defines the contract limit to equal the sum of one hundred thousand dollars per project, including labor, materials, and equipment as per the rates of the latest edition of the Associated Equipment Dealers Rental Rate Book and administrative overhead not to exceed 15%. <u>Present law</u> also provides a contract limit for the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections projects using inmate labor and specifies a contract limit for certain bridge projects performed by parishes with a population less than 16,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides a contract limit for public works administered by the division of administration's office of facility planning and control which is necessitated as a result of gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency. <u>Proposed law</u> adds contract limit shall be equal to the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_ dollars, including labor, materials, and equipment as per the rates in the latest edition of the Associated Equipment Dealers Rental Rate Book and administrative overhead not to exceed \_\_\_\_\_ percent.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the use of contractors domiciled in the state of Louisiana, and as preference for contractors which employ persons displaced from their homes by the declared disaster or emergency and contractors which employ persons domiciled in the state of Louisiana after all attempts have been exhausted to employ persons displaced from their homes by the declared disaster or emergency.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the waiver of such provisions by public entities subject to this contract limit.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
