- 8 for damages against the sheriff, the law enforcement agency, or employee thereof based
- 9 solely on his custody or detention in such prison or jail for a period of time in excess of that
- 10 required by the Code of Criminal Procedure or Title 15 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes
- of 1950 and which was caused by the impact of Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita, unless
- the sheriff or law enforcement agency or employee thereof willfully fails to release the
