HOSPITALS/CHARITY: Urges and requests the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center to discontinue discussion of expropriation for the construction of a public hospital in East Baton Rouge Parish

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request that the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center discontinue
3 the consideration of expropriation for the construction of a public hospital in East
4 Baton Rouge Parish.

5 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University is considering
6 the possible expropriation of property in East Baton Rouge Parish for the purpose of building
7 a public hospital; and

8 WHEREAS, property rights are a vital component of the state and federal
9 democracy; and

10 WHEREAS, private property rights are essential to a successful market economy;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, government expropriation limits the rights of individuals and the
13 freedom of the markets.

14 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
15 urge and request the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center to cease the
16 discussion of expropriation for the construction of a public hospital in East Baton Rouge
17 Parish.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
19 to the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University.
