- 8 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 17 and on page 2 delete lines 1 through 8 and insert the
- 9 following in lieu thereof:
- 10 <u>"§667.1. Delivery of fire insurance contract; disclosure of coverage; requirement to report</u>
- A. No fire insurance policy shall be delivered or issued for delivery in this state with respect to any residential property unless the insurer advises the insured in writing, prominently displayed on a form promulgated by the commissioner of insurance as an insert in the front of the policy, as to which coverages are included in the policy for which the insured has paid premiums. The insurer shall disclose whether or not the insured has coverage for flooding or mold and whether an increased deductible is required for hurricane damage.
