DIGEST

Chaisson (SB 68)

Proposed law creates the crime of conducting business without required licenses and permits.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that during a state of emergency declared by the governor, no person shall intentionally offer goods or services for sale or lease to the public unless that person possesses the licenses and permits required by <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not apply to religious, charitable, fraternal, civic educational, or social organizations.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for penalties of a fine of \$500 or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
