Provides an additional means by which public elementary and secondary schools may be transferred to the state's Recovery School District (Item #8)

The proposed legislation expands the authority of the Recovery School District such that all schools operating under the jurisdiction and direction of a school district that is in academic crisis shall be transferred to the Recovery School District, subject to the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education's approval. A district in academic crisis is defined as one in which for the 04-05 school year has more than 30 schools that are academically unacceptable or more than 50% of its students attend schools that are academically unacceptable pursuant to the School and District Accountability Program. Schools transferred from districts are exempt from current law requirements governing the return of schools that are no longer academically unacceptable to the local school system.
